

WHERE HAVE ALL THE FISHES GONE?

TRACKING SALMON AND SEA-TROUT IN THE OCEAN

In this illustrated presentation Ken Whelan will trace the development of modern animal tracking technologies. He will describe how modern versions of the tags used to track whales and dolphins are paying off in tracking individual salmon and sea trout at sea. He will illustrate the fascinating work of the Ocean Tracking Network (<http://oceantrackingnetwork.org/>). Building on this template, scientists from around the North Atlantic are planning an ambitious programme to partition the ocean, so as to figure out where our salmon are dying at sea and why?
